- Elbow orthosis

Day 2 includes Hands on Fabrication:

- Dynamic Extensor Tendon Orthosis with Outrigger
- Functional ulnar/median nerve
- PIP dynamic extension (capener)
- Radial Nerve Palsy orthosis with finger coils
- Static Progressive supination/pronation



September 28 | Manchester, NH “Neural Mobilization & Assessment Techniques for the Upper Quarter”

This course covers concepts for examination and quantifying restricted neural dynamics and basic intervention strategies for the upper quarter, including the cervical spine. Included is a critical review of the most up-to-date literature in peer-reviewed journals regarding the use of neural mobilization as an examination and treatment technique. This course includes laboratory sessions in which participants will practice neural mobilization and examination techniques. Participants are encouraged to wear loose, comfortable clothing.

This course is geared toward OT/OTAs and aims to educate the therapist in how to incorporate safe and effective application of PAMs into their current clinical practice. The Full Course consists of a web-based component, and a 2-day live workshop for lab demonstration and practice opportunities. Web Course or Live Workshop Only options available. This course follows NH state guidelines for PAMs certification (required 15 hrs in electrical stimulation education, and 6 hours in ultrasound education). **Note: participants will still have to complete supervision requirements in order to apply for NH certification.**

This half-day course aims to educate clinicians working in any setting how to safely and effectively manage thumb pain associated with thumb CMC arthritis. While the underlying pathology cannot be changed, this course provides participants with exceptional hands-on learning about the CMC joint and how effective pain management techniques CAN diminish pain and support your patients' return to function in as few as 1-4 visits. Participants will have ample opportunities to practice manual techniques, see orthotic fabrication demonstrations, and perform taping techniques.

November 2 | Augusta, ME “Simply, the Wrist”

This course will provide the participant with exceptional hands-on learning about the carpal joints, pathology, evaluation, and emerging concepts in conservative wrist rehabilitation interventions. Understanding the wrist is complex – this presentation aims to simplify the learning process with the use of anatomical models and hands on practice opportunities. It is important for the therapist to fully understand this joint's complex biomechanics and sensorimotor system that impacts alignment and function. Once this foundation has been established, participants will learn how to perform a basic clinical evaluation, and then learn how to create and execute an appropriate plan of care utilizing various fun, functional, and evidenced-based treatment interventions. Participants will also receive a FREE carpal puzzle model as part of this course!

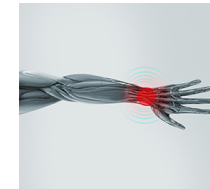

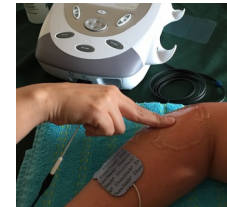

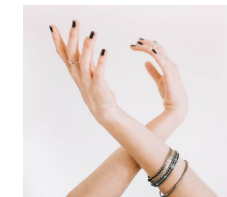
